Scholarships & Discounts for International Students

PROGRAM /NAME	TYPE OF AID	PROGRAM DETAILS	AMOUNT
FULL YEAR PAYMENT	Tuition Discount, Renewable	Payment in full of all the tuition and fees for first semester and second semester during first semester registration. A student can avail 5% tuition discount by the end of second semester. This 5% discount will be calculated on the total tuition for the year net of other tuition scholarships, subsidies or bursaries.	Approximately 5,400 – 6,400 Baht per year
FAMILY DISCOUNT	Tuition Discount, Renewable	A discount is available when two or more members of a student's immediate family (from the same household—living at home or in the residence halls) are enrolled at Asia-Pacific International University (AIU). The discount is awarded after the siblings have registered for the semester. A family discount of 5% of tuition is granted to the second sibling attending the University. For a family with three or more attending at the same time, a discount of 10% of tuition is given to the third and subsequent students.	Approximately 2,700 – 5,400 Baht per semester
NEW STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP	Scholarship, First Year Only	All new students can apply for the AIU New Student Scholarship. They can apply online and mail the required documents for acceptance no later than June 24 of each calendar year to avail of the 10,000 Baht scholarship. On enrollment, this scholarship will be granted by dividing over the first two semesters.	10,000 Baht for first year (divided in to 1st & 2nd Semesters)
SOUTHEAST ASIA UNION MISSION SDA SUBSIDY	Subsidy, for four years and one summer session	Students from SDA families or baptized members of SDA church who live in the countries of the Southeast Asia Union Mission territory (the nations of Brunei, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam) are eligible for the scholarship. They have to be full-time students in the regular University program. Other special conditions must be met by students to maintain the scholarship on an ongoing basis. Details and application forms are available from local Mission Offices or the University. <i>Note: Students applying for the SDA subsidy will not be eligible to receive the New Student Scholarship Discount of 10,000 Baht. A student will receive a grant of only one scholarship.</i>	25% of tuition and fees
CAMPUS WORK-STUDY PROGRAM	Work Program Matching Fund up to 50% for Breaks	AIU provides work opportunities to develop students' skills and to enable them to help finance their studies. Work opportunities, however, are limited, and in granting work assignments, preference is given to students who need to work as part of their financial plan. Working students can earn significantly more if they work during Christmas and summer break because the University provides matching funds to the labor credits earned during the break.	25% of tuition and fees expense for the year by working during the whole calendar year (including breaks).
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT WORTHY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP	Scholarship, Once a Year, Renewable	There are limited academic achievement/worthy student scholarships under each Faculty. They can be applied for while enrolled as a student and fulfilling the specific criteria under each Faculty.	Up to 50% of tuition and fees expenses for a semester
