All faculty are invited to the Banquet.

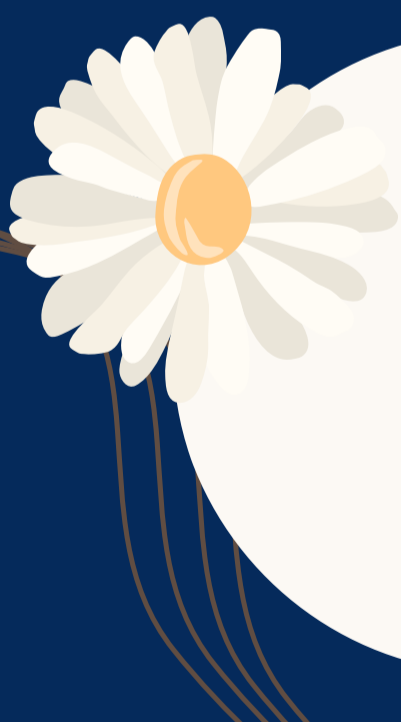
Thursday, May 18, 2023

Dress Code: College Uniform

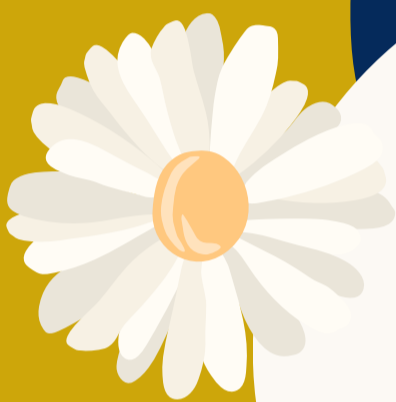
Baccalaureate Service-University Church

10:30 am. The academic procession will commence sharp.

Commencement Service-University Church

08:00 am. Graduands are requested to assemble in preparation for the academic procession at the right-hand side of the church building (in front of the Sabbath School classrooms).

09:00 am. Faculty will assemble in the Fellowship Hall and line up inside the Fellowship Hall.

Dress Code: Full Academic Regalia

Note: Graduands will not be allowed to enter the church if they are late for marching when the program begins. They will have to sit in the Fellowship Hall.

General Information

Graduation Regalia

The occasion requires formal dress. Muak Lek graduands can collect their academic regalia as follows:

Bangkok graduands can collect their academic regalia from the Faculty of Nursing office.

Graduation fees need to be paid in full before regalia can be picked up. A gown deposit of 1,000 Baht is required. The fee will be refunded to you after the gown has been returned in neat and clean condition.

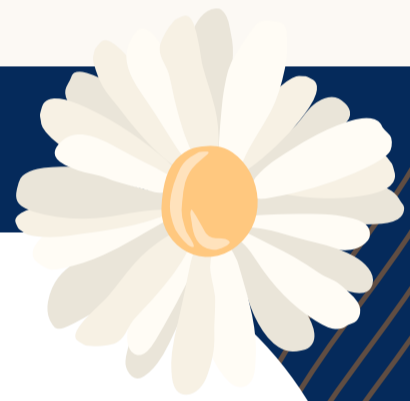
Collection of Transcript

Graduates can collect their transcript when they return the academic regalia and submit the clearance form. Without the clearance form, The Office of Admissions and Records is not authorized to provide the transcript or letter of certification.



Collection of Diploma

If a diploma needs to be mailed to an address, please inform the Office of Admissions and Records where to mail it. Fill in the Academic Document Request Form before you leave and arrange in advance for the payment of the mailing of your diploma. For instance, you can leave enough money in your account to cover the expense of mailing. If there is no money or inadequate amount in the account, you will need to arrange for payment before the diploma is mailed to you. A diploma is not mailed until an arrangement has been made to cover the mailing expense.
